

Madrid is hectic yet relaxed; it's a friendly vibrant place with masses to see, it's not sheer multitude that makes the city stir, It's the madrileño attitude -- a zest for socializing, taking to the streets and cheerfully maximizing every hour not spent working.

Madrid is Spain's largest city and its capital and is the center for international business. Strategically located in the geographic center of the Iberian Peninsula at an altitude of 646 m above sea level, Madrid has one of the most important historic centers of all the great European cities. This heritage merges seamlessly with the city's modern and convenient infrastructures, a wide-ranging offer of accommodation and services, and all the latest state-of-the-art technologies in audiovisual and communications media. These conditions, together with all the drive of a dynamic and open society —as well as high-spirited and friendly— have made this metropolis one of the great capitals of the Western world.

The capital has over 60 museums, which cover every field of human knowledge. Highlights include the Prado Museum, one of the world's most important art galleries; the Thyssen-Bornemisza Museum, with over 800 paintings ranging from primitive Flemish artists through to the avant-garde movements. And the Reina Sofía National Art Centre, dedicated to contemporary Spanish art and containing works by Picasso, Joan Miró, Salvador Dalí and Juan Gris, among others.



Yes, Madrid is for travelers interested in famous paintings and stunning architecture, but it's also, and maybe more so, for those looking for an unhurried good time. Madrid has a lot to offer!! The characteristic that most impacts first-time visitors is its nightlife. The Spanish schedule generally runs later than most, but even more in Madrid. Eat dinner at 10pm and your night on the town begins to jump when other European cities pubs are closing and continues 'til the sun comes up. "Salir" - to go out - only counts if you've made it past 4am. Otherwise it's just a "vuelta," or a stroll around the block.

Usually, January is a cold time in Madrid with temperatures ranging from 0 C to 10 C, so bring a coat and try to enjoy the wonderful hot meals the madrileños offer! A short stay in Spain's capital city will leave you smitten!!




The Pangea Master.
